DIRECTOR'S NOTE



Keep Calm and Carry On. Such a critical campaign for the British in World War Two. It serves a much smaller yet critical role for us at Kainos through the ongoing phases of the pandemic. While in the beginning, we felt like it was a life-or-death struggle keeping the virus at bay and out of our facilities, now we are getting on with our work and our lives, while keeping in mind the COVID risks and necessary precautions.

Clients are engaging in the community, volunteering, having fun, connecting with missed family and friends. It feels delightful, yet some things are still different. Regular temperature readings, extra cleanings, and smaller groups on many of our excursions. We still try and avoid eating indoors at restaurants.

Our work at Kainos continues with staff helping clients find jobs, clients moving to more independent settings to live and regulatory agencies catching up on their visits. We have concluded countless Zoom meetings and have successfully passed multiple licensing inspections, GGRC Quality Assurance consultations and a triennial visit from the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities.

All our events needed to be cancelled for 2021 (except for the Kainos/Downtown Business Group beer and wine booth at the Redwood City Concerts in the Square). We are hopeful that 2022 will see a return to more of our traditional fund and fun-raisers.

Over the summer, we held our most successful membership drive ever. Thank you! If you haven't contributed yet (or if you have and are feeling extra generous) we have another opportunity for you:


CARF - Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities



Every three years Kainos Vocational Services is evaluated in depth by CARF (Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities) from programming, to accessibility, to performance measurement to financials.

2020 marked our survey date for renewal... but like everything else Covid-19 changed that.

The evaluation was cancelled! Later that year CARF let us know that we would have a virtual assessment in March of 2021. 


