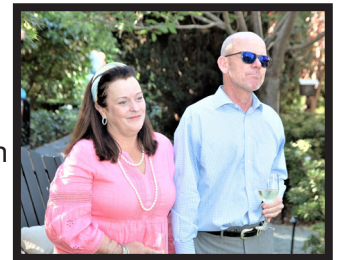

DIRECTOR'S NOTE from Andy Frisch

Community Care licensing which regulates many of our programs tells us that the state of emergency that we have been operating under for covid will end on February 28, 2023. I've marked my calendar. Close to three years to the date when covid began for us. We are told the emergency will be over.

For us at Kainos, it is a little tricky. We've made a commitment to those who live with us, those who attend our day programs, those we support in employment in the community and those who work for us, that their safety and well being will be our paramount concern.

So, yes, 2023 approaches. We plan on having our day programs running at full capacity five days a week. We expect our clients to be out engaging the community, gaining, skills, connections and experiences. WE expect to be catching up on some of the fun that was missed.

Yet, we will still have the responsibility to make sure we are keeping our clients and staff safe. I imagine that we will be some of the last places that expects staff to wear masks while working. We will continue with surveillance testing as long as it is feasible. We will stay abreast of all developments in case things turn south and we will be prepared to act if they do.

If there is one thing that has come through to me in bright and vivid colors through the pandemic, it is that the ties that we have always believed made us strong at Kainos, those between clients, staff and clients and our families and community supported are bonds of love. I have seen countless acts of kindness that have brightened dark days and affirmed the core aspects of our mission.

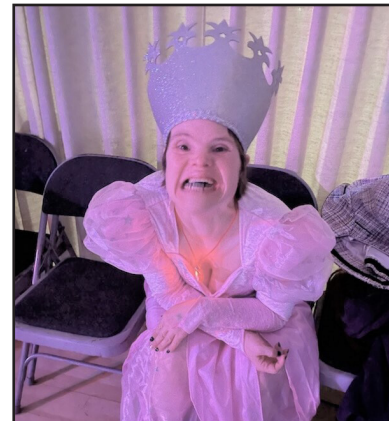

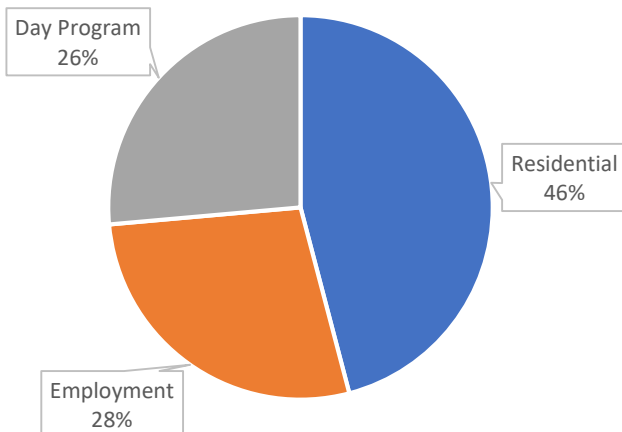

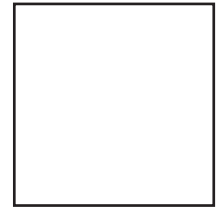
