Director's Note

Welcome to Kainos' 50th Anniversary! We are so proud and honored to have reached this milestone. Most home-grown organizations do not survive this long. That we have is a testament to the clear vision of our founders, to the support and engagement of our families and local community and to the guidance of our board. My deepest gratitude goes to the clients who invite us to be an important part of their lives and our staff who make all of our work happen.

The ingredients that allowed Kainos to succeed at its creation are the same that allow us to thrive today. We were founded as a collaboration between families, funders, local community and clients. All critically important for us to start our first community-based programs and still equally important today. Today we have grown to include our staff of 125 as an invaluable part of that team. The collaboration of all of these groups is what allows us to continue to succeed in helping our clients live their best lives.

Dorothy Philbrick's original vision can be found in our name Kainos - ancient Greek for *New Beginnings*. Dorothy wanted a Home, a place of care and support, and a Training Center, helping people learn skills that would unlock greater independence. I think if Dorothy were to see us today, she would see that we have stayed true to that vision. The main difference she would see is that our original practice of tough love has transformed into unconditional love and kindness.

I came to Kainos in the early years of our homes. I remember leading groups at the Triplex where we would speak about the commitment and shared responsibility we had to each other. We knew that if any of us acted foolishly in public that all of Kainos and all people with disabilities would be painted with that same brush. We knew that we had to be examples for each other. I believe that was some of the basis for the strong sense of community that we all feel for each other today.

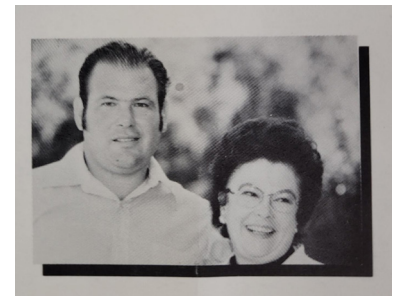
